

Status of The Work on Inter-connectivity of MoEF IT Systems for Improved Supply Chain Control

Objective

To ensure direct communications between 3 systems (SIPUHH, SIRPBBI, and SILK) to guarantee that certification status of operators can be checked at all times so certified timber only travels through the supply chain

Deliverables status

a. The coverage of **SILK is expanded**

- template for data uploads by CABs **done**
- new platforms within SILK to accommodate new data **done**
- data uploads by CABs **done**
- improvement of appearance and functioning **done**,
- NC platform in SILK is agreed with CSOs to be improved in terms of detail of information provided and new process for CSOs to directly upload suspected NC case material (the implementation of this work will conclude on 29 February 2024)

b. **SILK, SIPUHH, and SIRPBBI** systems are interconnected

- SIPUHH and SIRPBBI can check the certification status of operators in real time in SILK and take appropriate decisions.

c. SIPUHH is now connected to **SiINas at the Ministry of Industry**

- Enables better coverage and oversight of secondary industries (<https://voi.id/en/economy/339642>)

d. SILK is now connected to **INATRADE and INSW**

- in order to get data on timber import and other information.

Next Steps: MoEF plans to make SILK designated data hub for geo-location and deforestation-free data
