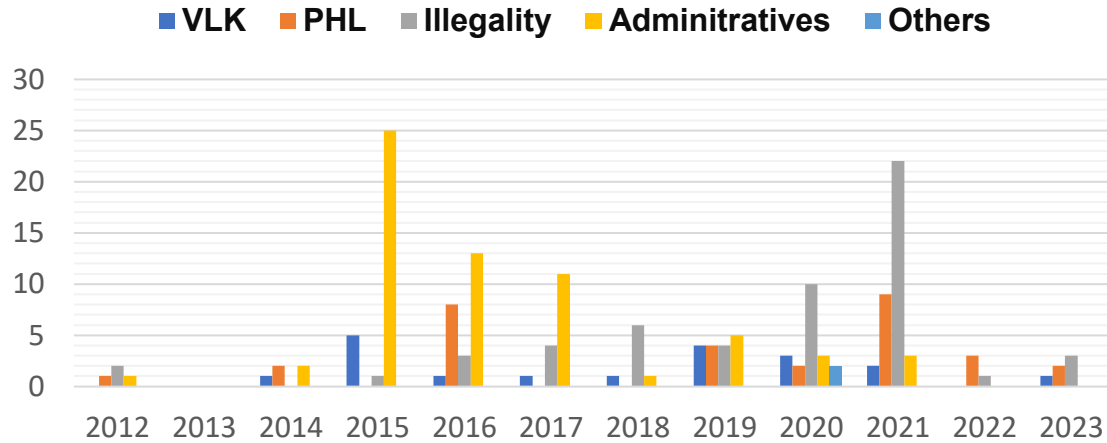

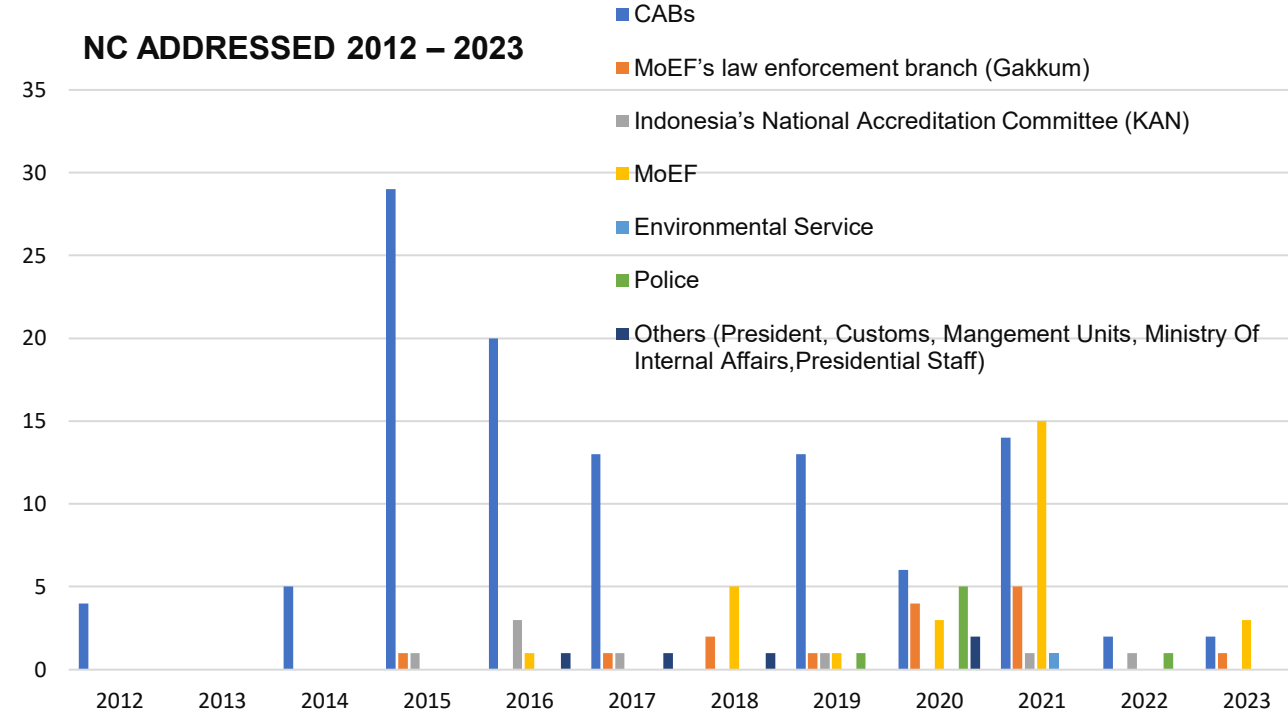

# Non Compliance (NC) Cases JPIK 2012-2023

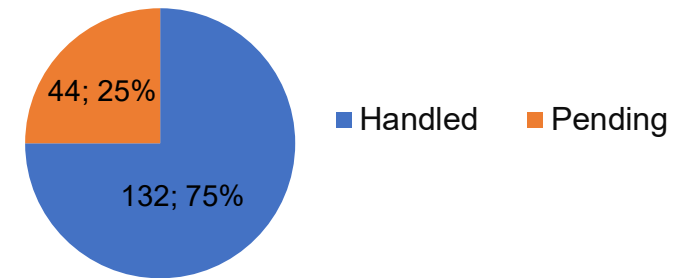
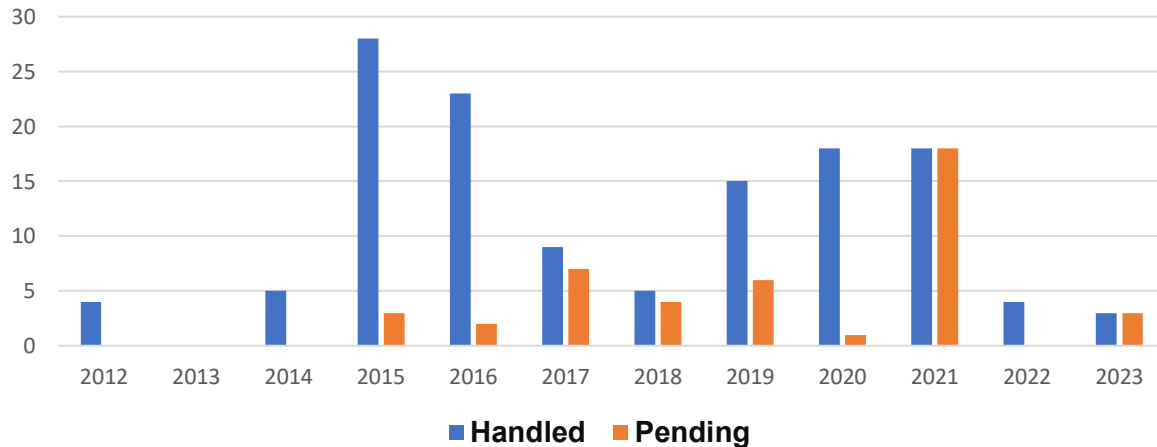
## Types of NC 2012-2023

# Stock take of JPIK monitoring 2012-2023

- JPIK maintains a long-term **database** of NC cases – to learn lessons and improve
- For the period **2012-2023**, JPIK noted **172 cases of suspected NC (or approx. 15/yr)**
- These were **reported** CABs, KLHK (DG PHL, Gakkum) and other agencies
- **Types** of NC cases:
  - administrative issues (39%)
  - Illegality (33%)
  - issues with PHPL sustainability standard implementation (17%)
  - issues with VLK legality standard implementation (11%).
- **Where** cases have been reported to:
  - 63% of cases to CABs
  - 22% to DG PHL at MoEF
  - 7% to MoEF's law enforcement branch (Gakkum)
  - 4% to Indonesia's National Accreditation Committee (KAN)
  - 4% to the Police
- **Status:**
  - As of 2023, 142 cases (**82%**) have been **addressed** by responsible agencies, while 23 (**18%**) were not resolved or are pending.
  - However, addressed does not always mean that cases have been concluded or closed to the satisfaction of all parties
  - Continuous follow up and monitoring are needed
- **Conclusions:**
  - Independent monitors like JPIK operate as envisioned in the FLEGT VPA
  - Monitoring and reporting NC cases is important for the credibility of SVLK and the VPA
  - The handling of reported NC cases is improving
  - JPIK expects that improved NC platform will make NC reporting simpler and more effective
